

I look forward to seeing all the amazing inquiries our students undertake as the term progresses.

There have been a number of building projects taking place over the holidays, and improvements to the school. If you have visited the Leonard block since the end of last term, you will see the improvements we have made to the classes. We also have tiger turf on site constructing our new sports turf in the junior school, as well as Vea contractors working to fix our crumbling wall to restore it to its former glory. All of this work exemplifies our commitment to ensuring our students have a safe, inspiring environment that meets the needs of a well-rounded modern curriculum. In the coming months, we will begin planning for the refurbishment of the junior block (room 5, 6, 8, and 9). We will work to ensure that the disruption to any classes is minimal, as we create learning environments that cherish the history and character of the

block, while providing the best environment possible for our

students.
