Welcome back to term three. We embark on our new inquiry 'Heroes who made history', where we explore the concept of heroism. While the inquiry looks different at all levels of the school, that core concept runs through all classes.

This is the term where we start looking forward to 2020 and making plans to ensure every classroom is a powerful laboratory of learning for every child. The Curriculum Council begin their important work of talking to children about what they'd like to inquire into next year soon. I encourage you to talk with your children at home about this, and about what contexts for learning they would love to explore. We also start to look at our school organisation around this time, to ensure we have the right staff in the right levels to ensure our desired average of 25 children per class.

Make sure we know everything we need to know!

Because of the roll growth we have experienced over the last three years, we are unable to accept out of zone students as we have in the past. If you have moved out of zone since enrolling and have siblings who will be starting in 2020, they will need to apply as out of zone students. We do our best to accommodate siblings of current students, so to ensure we have a place for them, please email enrolment@parnell.school.nz and let Kathy know.

If you know things are changing for your family and you won't be at Parnell District School in 2020, equally we'd like to know as soon as possible so that we can plan accordingly. Please email enrolment@parnell.school.nz and let Kathy know that too.

You will have an opportunity to give us feedback around the class placement of your child over the coming term, and we'll let you know about that soon. We do work tirelessly to ensure class placement for each child is appropriate. Information about their learning style and strengths and talents they have that you'd like to see them exploring are helpful, however we can not accept any requests for specific teachers or students to be in your class, so please don't include this in your information as it will be ignored.


School Policies



Inquiry

Term 2 has been extra busy with our exciting inquiry topic 'Make me Move'. The students in Room 30 have been working hard to form an inquiry question and create a presentation under the forms of drama, slam poetry or dance. Most students created innovative and inventive projects that captured movement and each student enjoyed watching. This term we are looking forward to learning about 'Heroes who made history' and creating a presentation in the form of either a formal speech, a slam poem, a rap or a picture presentation. We are excited to learn about heroism and we already have a slight start as we have already learnt about presenting slam poems, so we are super prepared for this term.



Literacy/Art

In literacy this term, we were making our words move through the power of SLAM POETRY! Each student selected an animal and created a slam poem about their animals.

We wrote our poems using language features such as personification, similes, metaphors and onomatopoeia to name a few. We had so much fun presenting our poems to the class. On top of our SLAM, we also created artwork to enhance our poems even more. We looked at mixing colours together and moving our paintbrushes in a specific way to blend colours and create an ombre effect.



Sport

Last term we had lots of sport demonstrations where we learnt new skills such as Lawn Bowls and Hockey. It was enjoyable and interesting to learn and play sports that we normally wouldn't play, especially lawn bowls, as we thought it was only for old people! 😊

We learnt a lot of new skills and can't wait for Cross Country and other sports this term!



Mathematics

Earlier in the term, we learnt adding, multiplying and dividing fractions. Not many children seem to like fractions, but this task was exceptionally enjoyable, as each child took around yummy chocolates home with them.
