Kia ora e te whānau,

The Parnell District School team got the sad news this week that one of our former teachers, Jill Bonniface, passed away on Friday. Jill worked with us up until 2018, and many of our community will remember Jill as a learning leader in years 0-3 and an amazing teacher in our junior school. Jill was known amongst her colleagues as a kind and caring person, evident in her interactions with staff and students. A group of our staff will represent our school at her funeral to pay our respects to her family.

Please keep our children safe on the road!

Parent behaviour at pick up and drop off time continues to put our student's safety at risk. When our friends at Auckland Transport improved our school crossing on St Stephens Avenue, they increased the space that is restricted for parking with yellow lines. It is illegal to stop on yellow lines. When you stop on yellow lines, you make it more difficult for our road safety team to see moving traffic and put every child at risk. While Auckland Transport will be present and ticketing parents who stop on yellow lines, I want to implore our community to act in a way that prioritises all children's safety over their convenience.
