Kia ora e te whānau,

At Parnell District School, we are committed to ensuring our curriculum and classroom programmes are providing the best learning opportunities for our students. We have a couple of opportunities for our community to continue their feedback.

Join us to be part of our consultation

First, we'd love to invite our whānau to join us for some focus groups to follow up on the school survey we did last year. We got some major themes out of the survey, but our next step is to sit down with groups of parents to discuss their experiences with our curriculum and the learning opportunities their children have experienced. Bradly, we'd like to talk about learning programmes, our school culture and climate, our resources, and how we can best work together with our community. Come along to hear about how we teach the health curriculum, what is covered and when, and help us understand what is important for your whānau in this area.

Summer Reminders

As the weather finally starts to warm up, I wanted to remind you all of our expectations to keep every child safe

- Children can not be on site unsupervised before 8:30 am or after 3:15 pm

When your children are on site, we take their safety very seriously. Before 8:30 am and after 3:15 pm, teachers and staff are not available to supervise children. Being on-site too early or too late is very dangerous. Remember, if your child is here before 8:30 or after 3:15, they need a parent or caregiver supervising them on site.

- Every child needs a school hat for morning tea, lunchtime, and outdoor learning activities

 As part of our commitment to keeping our children safe in the sun, every child needs a school hat in terms one and four. If your child doesn't have a hat, they will miss out on break time and school learning activities outside. Hats can be purchased from the office or the school uniform centre.
 - Please don't park on yellow lines around the school

We continue to have parents parking on the yellow lines around the school crossings. This makes it dangerous for children crossing the road as well as other traffic. Please do not park or pause on the yellow lines for drop off or pick up. Our friends at Auckland Transport are closely patrolling the area after a series of safety concerns. You will get a ticket for stopping on yellow lines even if you wait in your car.

Get your diary out and book on the 11th of December for our annual Celebration of Learning held at the Parnell Cathedral. The ceremony will start at 2:30 pm, and we expect it to be completed by 4 pm. We'd suggest arriving by 2:15 to ensure you find a seat and don't miss the start!



EOTC week is coming up!

Education outside the classroom (EOTC) has long been part of kiwi kids' learning journey. It includes all kinds of learning opportunities in our environment, including health sports and physical activity. At Parnell District School, EOTC week takes place in term four every year, making sure every child gets to experience the benefits of learning outside. EOTC week includes camps and trips for children through the school, which we can't do without parental help. To ensure the safety of every child, we need a ratio of 1 adult to 8 children, with the ratio lowering to 1:6 around water or 1:4 for any event where children are swimming or in water. We thank all the amazing parents who have volunteered to come along on camps, but we also need lots of parents for our day trips and at-school activities. Look out for more information.
